

## NOMINATION PETITION

This Petition is to place \_\_\_\_\_ [member's name] in nomination for election to a Board of Director position at the First Harvest Federal Credit Union's Annual Meeting being held on August 25, 2026.

Petitioner must obtain the signatures of 1% of the membership subject to a maximum of 500 signatures. As the Credit Union has 50,216 members as of March 31, 2026, the petition must have at least 500 signatures of *members in good standing*. The period for submitting nominations by petition begins on June 1, 2026, and closes on July 9, 2026.

Petitions received after July 9, 2026, will not be accepted and petitioner will not be eligible for nomination for election to the Board of Director position.

We the undersigned, as members of First Harvest Federal Credit Union, petition to have \_\_\_\_\_ [member's/nominee's name] placed in nomination for election to a Board of Director position.

At the Annual Meeting and Election all persons nominated by either the Nominating Committee or by Petition shall be placed before the Members in attendance for a vote. An election will not be conducted by ballot and there will be no nominations from the floor when there is only one nominee for each position to be filled. Nominations cannot be made from the floor unless insufficient nominations have been made by the Nominating Committee or by petition to provide for one Nominee for each position to be filled or circumstances prevent the candidacy of the one nominee for the position. When nominations are closed, Tellers of Election will be appointed by the Chair and ballots will be distributed. The vote will be taken and tallied by the Supervisory Committee and the results announced. The election will be determined by plurality vote. The results of the Annual Election will be announced at the Annual Meeting.
